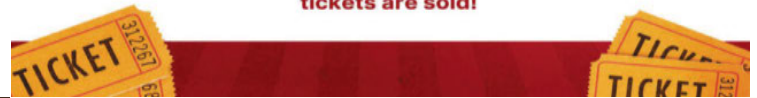

Epiphany Proclamation 2024

Know, dear brothers and sisters, that, as we have rejoiced at the Nativity of our Lord Jesus Christ, so by leave of God's mercy we announce to you also the joy of his Resurrection, who is our Savior. On the Fourteenth Day of February will fall Ash Wednesday, and the beginning of the fast of the most sacred Lenten season. On the Thirty first Day of March you will celebrate with joy Easter Day, the Paschal feast of our Lord Jesus Christ. On the Twelfth Day of May will be the Ascension of our Lord Jesus Christ. On the Nineteenth Day of May the feast of Pentecost. On the Second day of June, the feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. On the First day of December the First Sunday of Advent of our Lord Jesus Christ, to whom is honor and glory for ever and ever. Amen. *

The Angelus

This prayer is prayed in the morning, when you get up, at noon, and at the end of the work day, traditionally 6 AM, 12 Noon, and 6 PM. If prayed by more than one person, one person leads and the others respond.
