How amazing for our parish to celebrate Confirmation just a few days before Pentecost! In light of that, we thought it would be a good opportunity to refresh the beautiful and the complementary aspects of the sacraments! Enjoy!

The Sacrament of Baptism (Day 1)

A sacrament is an *encounter* with God; a visible <u>sign</u> of an invisible *grace*~God's <u>free gift</u> to us, his presence in our lives.

Every sacrament gives a sacramental grace!

Baptism does 3 things for us (the Sacramental Grace received in Baptism):

- Removes Original Sin (also a sanctifying grace)
- Makes us members of Christ's Church
- Makes us a Child of God. We become a part of God's family. Like a child has the qualities of his parents, so do we obtain the qualities of God known as the fruits of the Holy Spirit (9 of them-- Love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, faithfulness, goodness generosity, and self-control).

The Sacraments of Confirmation (Day Infinity)

Sacramental Grace received:

- the ability to witness to the love of God in our everyday lives. We become "Apostles" of Christ
- The 7 gifts of the Holy Spirit
 Wisdom | Knowledge | Courage (Fortitude) |
 Right Judgment | Understanding | Piety
 (Holiness) | Wonder and Awe (Fear of the Lord).

What is the relationship between the gifts and the fruits of the Spirit: - the gifts are tools to bring us and others closer to God (make us more like the fruits). If you use your gifts, you get to eat your fruit!

Who is the Holy Spirit? — GOD WITHIN US! Our advocate, our (formed) conscience.

Symbols of the Holy Spirit

- Wind- can't see it but can see its effects.
- Tongues of Fire- excited "FIRED-UP" about our faith.
- New languages- the ability to do things we never could before.
- Dove- peace and purity






